

Covid-19, new guidelines regarding children/students in preschool and school

From Tuesday 1 December, the public health authority has come up with new guidelines regarding children/pupils in preschool and school.

Children and students living with someone who has covid-19 should stay at home.

The Swedish Public Health Agency is now changing the recommendations so that staff in schools and preschools can focus on the pedagogical work.

Middle-school and other compulsory school forms, as well as preschool, are essential for children's and young people's development and learning. Both the school and the preschool have a socially important function. The starting point in the pandemic is that the activities must be open and teaching must take place in the school.
