

Do you care for a relative or close friend?

You have the right to get support.

The municipality of Ludvika can give you support.



Who is a family carer?

A family carer is a person who helps someone who is ill, old or has a physical or mental disability.

A person who is a substance abuser can also have help.

A person who can have help should be registered and live in the municipality of Ludvika.

The municipality must offer support to families.

The support is for you, the carer, who helps the person in the home.

The support is also for you who have a close relative living in a special home.



What support can the municipality give?

The usual form of support is help in the home.

You apply to the municipality to get help in the home.

The municipality decides in line with The Social Services Act.

Another support is to talk to a counsellor.

You can talk to a counsellor on your own or in a group.

You apply direct to Family Support for counselling.

What do I do?

You can contact Family Support if you have questions.

You can also contact Family Support if you want advice or counselling.

Everyone who works in family support has a duty to keep your information secret.

There is no charge for family support. This is a service the municipality offers.
